AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A NEW SPEED LIMIT  
ON QUEENSTOWN ROAD

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Trussville, Alabama considers the safety of the public to be one of the greatest concerns; and


WHEREAS, Code of Alabama, permits local authorities to establish the maximum speed limit on any street, unpaved road, or alley under its jurisdiction and control; and

WHEREAS, the Trussville Public Safety Committee has reviewed and recommended that the speed limit on Queenstown Road should be established at thirty-five (35) miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Trussville, Alabama that the speed limit on Queenstown Road shall be and is established as thirty-five (35) miles per hour, and that appropriate signs reflecting this speed limit shall be erected.
