

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-024-AS

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A SPEED LIMIT  
ON SOUTH CHALKVILLE ROAD AND ROPER ROAD

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Trussville, Alabama considers the safety of the public to be one of the greatest concerns; and


WHEREAS, Code of Alabama, permits local authorities to establish the maximum speed limit on any street, unpaved road, or alley under its jurisdiction and control; and

WHEREAS, the Trussville Public Safety Committee has reviewed and recommended that the speed limit on South Chalkville Road from Main Street to Queenstown Road should be established at thirty (30) miles per hour, and the speed limit on Roper Road from Queenstown Road to the Moody City Limit shall be and is established as forty (40) miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Trussville, Alabama that the speed limit on South Chalkville Road shall be and is established as thirty (30) miles per hour, and the speed limit on Roper Road from Queenstown Road t the Moody City Limit shall be and is established as forty (40) miles per hour, and that appropriate signs reflecting this speed limit shall be erected.
