**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A SPEED LIMIT
ON TRUSSVILLE CLAY ROAD**


WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Trussville, Alabama considers the safety of the public to be one of the greatest concerns; and

WHEREAS, Code of Alabama, permits local authorities to establish the maximum speed limit on any street, unpaved road, or alley under its jurisdiction and control; and


WHEREAS, the Trussville Public Safety Committee has reviewed and recommended that the speed limit on Trussville Clay Road should be established at thirty-five (35) miles per hour from Poplar Street to Memory Lane.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Trussville, Alabama that the speed limit on Trussville Clay road shall be and is established as thirty-five (35) miles per hour, and that appropriate signs reflecting this speed limit shall be erected.

ADOPTED and APPROVED this the 9th day of July., 2020.


