AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE INSTALLATION OF TWO ADDITIONAL STOP SIGNS AND A CROSSWALK AT THE INTERSECTION OF BETHUNE PARKWAY AND CALDWELL DRIVE TO CREATE A FOUR-WAY STOP

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Trussville, Alabama considers the safety of the public to be one of the greatest concerns; and
