ORDINANCE No. 2022 - 409 - ADM

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING TWO DOWNTOWN AREA PROPERTIES OWNED BY THE CITY OF TRUSSVILLE AS SURPLUS AND APPROVING THE SALE OF BOTH PROPERTIES TO TRUSSVILLE REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the City of Trussville, Alabama ("City") is presently the owner of the property located at Lot B of the Braden's Corner Resurvey 1; and

WHEREAS, the City is presently the owner of the property located at Lot 1D-B of the Resurvey of Lot 1D within the Trussville Entertainment District Phase 1; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-47-20 of the <u>Code of Alabama</u> (1975) permits real property that is not presently needed for a public or municipal purpose to be declared surplus and to be disposed of through conveyance; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TRUSSVILLE, ALABAMA, as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby declared surplus and established that the aforementioned Lot B and Lot 1D-B, more particularly identified in **Exhibit A** of the City of Trussville, Alabama, are no longer needed for public or municipal purpose.

Section 2. The City of Trussville, Alabama conveys both lots to the Trussville Redevelopment Authority, an Alabama non-profit corporation, for a certain consideration

Section 3. Pursuant to the authority granted by section 11-47-20 of the <u>Code of Alabama</u> (1975,) the mayor of the City of Trussville, Alabama, is hereby authorized and directed to execute a statutory warranty deed and a conveyance contract in the name of the to implement the sale and effectuate its intent.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption, approval, and publication as required by law.
