## CITY OF TRUSSVILLE MINUTES

## **JUNE 9, 2022 SPECIAL SESSION**

The City Council of the City of Trussville met in **special session** on **Thursday**, **June 9**, **2022** at 5 pm at Trussville City Hall, with Council President Pro Tem Lisa L. Bright presiding over the meeting and City Clerk Dan Weinrib serving as recording secretary.

President Pro Tem Bright called the meeting to order.

President Pro Tem Bright recognized Councilor Taylor, who introduced a proposed resolution requesting a new traffic light at the Hamilton Place commercial development/Winn Dixie shopping center intersection with Main Street (US Highway 11) He moved and Councilor Anderson seconded the motion for approval. **UNANIMOUS. Resolution No. 2022-25** 

President Pro Tem Bright then opened a public hearing on a proposed alcohol license for applicant Trussville Social LLC. Owner and new city resident Jeremy Reeves introduced himself to the city council and public. He answered Councilor Taylor's questions about previous experience, history of alcohol-related citations and staff training, to the elected officials' satisfaction. This will be his seventh restaurant. He anticipates it opening by the start of July. It's located at 114 South Chalkville Road. Since nobody else spoke up, President Pro Tem Bright closed the public hearing.

Councilor Short then introduced a proposed resolution granting Trussville Social permission for its alcohol license. He moved and Councilor Anderson seconded the motion for approval. **UNANIMOUS. Resolution No. 2022-26** 

With no further public business, the Council promptly adjourned at 5:10 pm, then immediately convened its regularly scheduled agenda workshop.
