
An Ordinance Amending the Bond Amount of Best Management Practices Approval Requirements & Renumbering a Subsection of Erosion & Sedimentation Control Within the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 38 – Environment


BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Trussville, Alabama that Code of Ordinances Section 38-154 is hereby amended as follows:



- (~~2~~ 3) The control plan must be accompanied by a letter of credit, a surety bond or a cash bond, with the city having the right to determine which type of security shall be furnished. A letter of credit, a surety bond or a cash bond (a letter of credit, a surety bond and a cash bond shall be herein collectively referred to as "security") shall be furnished to the city in accordance with the following provisions:
- a. The official shall require a letter of credit, a surety bond or a cash bond in such amount as specified herein to assure that the work, if not completed or if not in accordance with the permitted plans and specifications will be corrected to eliminate hazardous conditions, erosion and/or drainage problems. In lieu of a letter of credit or a surety bond required by the city, the owner may file a cash bond with the city in an amount equal to that which would be required in the letter of credit or the surety bond.
 - b. The security shall contain, or have attached to it as an exhibit, a legal description of the site. The security shall remain in effect for such reasonable period of time as may be required by the official.
 - c. The security for clearing operations only shall be in the amount of ~~\$2,000.00~~ \$10,000.00 per acre for each acre, or fraction of an acre, disturbed or affected by such operations.
 - d. The security for earthwork or clearing and earthwork operations shall be in the amount of ~~\$5,000.00~~ \$10,000.00 per acre for each acre, or fraction of an acre, disturbed or affected by such operations.
 - e. The security for earthwork or clearing and earthwork operations for an individual single family residence may be reduced to ~~\$3,000.00~~ \$10,000.00 with proof of completion of either the Jefferson County Erosion Workshop or the qualified credentialed inspector (QCI) certification.

- f. Security equal to double the amounts required in subsections c. and d. herein, shall be required where clearing or earthwork is performed in areas designated as floodways, floodplains or areas susceptible to landslides.
- g. Each letter of credit must be issued by a bank which has its principal office in either Jefferson County or St. Clair County, Alabama.
- h. Each letter of credit must be issued by a bank which is reasonably satisfactory to the city and each surety bond must be issued by a surety company which is qualified to do business in Alabama and which is otherwise reasonably satisfactory to the city.


