Dear City of Trussville Resident:

We are honored to announce Amwaste will be your new solid waste, debris, and bulk trash service provider. This communication includes your scheduled service day, important notes, and collection guidelines. For full details, please see the opposite side of this letter.

**Effective December 1, 2022, the collection day for your address is **Monday**.**

Here are some important notes:

- Place all materials and bags inside your cart(s), use 2nd cart as needed.
- Bag all trash to prevent wind-blown litter and unsanitary conditions.
- Please have your cart out for service by 6:00AM on your scheduled days.
- **Place all materials and bags inside your cart(s), use 2nd cart as needed.**
- Do not place loose materials on ground, service is completed by an automated vehicle, it is designed to lift and dump the contents inside your cart.
- Please ensure lid is closed to prevent wind-blown litter and animal nuisance.
- Wash your cart periodically with water, soap and mild bleach to prevent residue and odor build up.
- If you receive medical or age qualified back door service, place your cart in plain sight with safe and unobstructed access.
- Amwaste personnel **WILL NOT** enter gates, doors, garages or fenced areas to complete back door service.

### Materials Accepted

#### These materials WILL be collected:

rolled carpet • glass doors (glass must be broken and placed in a cardboard box) • alkaline, manganese, and carbon-zinc batteries • fluorescent bulbs • household amounts of pesticides, herbicides, and fertilizers • moving boxes (broken down) • packing materials (bagged) • appliances (refrigerated appliances require a Freon removal tag issued by a certified technician).

### Materials Not Accepted

#### These materials WILL NOT be collected:

construction debris • blocks • bricks • concrete • piles of dirt • tile • tires • more than household amounts of hazardous waste • car batteries • large car parts (engines, rotors, etc.) • landscape or railroad cross ties • medical waste • needles • animal carcasses.

## Collection Schedule

- Waste is collected 1x per week.
- Carts must be out by 6:00am on your scheduled service day.
- Collection missed or other issue? Please call Public Works at (205) 655-0319.

## Holidays

- Annual observed holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving & Christmas. Dates may be subject to change.
- Service will be delayed by one day following the holiday. If the holiday falls on a weekend, service will not be delayed.

## Backdoor Collection

- Backdoor service is available at no cost for residents with a medically certified need. For more information, please call Public Works at (205) 655-0319.
- Amwaste personnel WILL NOT enter gates, doors, garages or fenced areas to complete back door service.

## Cart Use Guidelines

- Use existing carts(s) for service. If your cart is broken, please call Public Works at (205) 655-0319 to order a replacement cart.
- Place all materials and bags inside your cart(s), use 2nd cart as needed.
- Please have your cart out for service and placed as referenced in the cart placement column; no later than 6:00AM on your scheduled service day.
- Do not place carts on: sidewalk, storm drain cover; gutter, steep slopes; elevated platforms; under low-hanging utility line or overhead obstructions; or within 6' of any fixed object (hedges, light post, mailbox, vehicle, etc.)
- Bag all materials to prevent wind-blown litter and unsanitary cart conditions.
- Periodically wash your cart with water, soap and mild bleach to prevent residue and odor.
- Double-check to ensure cart(s) are spaced 3-4' apart and are not within 6' of any fixed object.
- Break down cardboard & boxes and place them in your cart, use 2nd cart as needed.
- As a reminder, the vehicle is designed to lift and dump your cart and its contents. It is not designed to pick up material from the ground.
- Carts contents may not exceed 50lbs.

## Debris & Bulk Collection

- Bulk and brush will be collected every other week Monday through Friday. To request service for large piles of yard debris or bulk items, please call Public Works at (205) 655-0319.
- Small amounts of loose debris may be bagged and placed in your cart each week. If it cannot be bagged and will not fit in the cart, please call Public Works at (205) 655-0319 to request debris and bulk service.
- Only homeowner-generated materials will be collected. Contracted work (landscaping, construction, etc.) must be removed by the contractor. Use a roll-off dumpster for construction/remodeling projects generating significant debris.
- Place materials no more than 3' from the curb and away from obstructions.
- Branches may not be longer than 6' long.
- Cross ties (railroad ties) will not be collected. They contain creosote and are not accepted by landfills.
- Refrigerated appliances require a Freon removal tag issued by a certified technician.
