

Ordinance No. 2023 - 021 - ADM

An Ordinance Declaring Certain Real Property Owned by the City of Trussville as Surplus

WHEREAS, the City of Trussville, Alabama (“City”) is presently the owner of certain real property located at 6287 Service Road; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-47-20 of the Code of Alabama (1975) permits real property that is not presently needed for a public or municipal purpose to be declared surplus and to be disposed of through conveyance; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TRUSSVILLE, ALABAMA, as follows:


Section 1. It is hereby declared surplus and established that the aforementioned real property, more particularly identified in **Exhibit A**, is no longer needed for public or municipal purpose.

Section 2. The City may convey the property for a certain consideration.


Section 3. Pursuant to the authority granted by section 11-47-20 of the Code of Alabama (1975), the mayor of the City of Trussville, Alabama, is hereby authorized and directed to execute a deed in the name of the City to implement the sale and effectuate its intent.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption, approval, and publication as required by law.



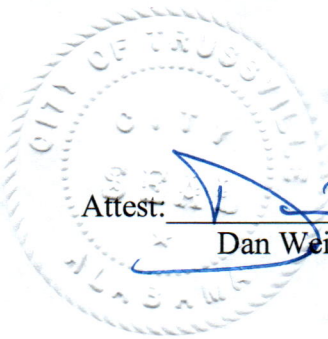


