

CITY OF TRUSSVILLE MINUTES

SEPTEMBER 30, 2024 SPECIAL SESSION

The City Council of the City of Trussville met in **special session** on **Monday, September 30, 2024**, at 8:03 am at the City Hall Annex, with Council President Jaime Anderson presiding and City Clerk Dan Weinrib serving as recording secretary. The purpose of this council meeting was to consider a proposed FY2025 budget and a proposed cost-of-living-adjustment for city employees.

President Anderson called the meeting to order.

President Anderson recognized Councilor Short who introduced the proposed FY2025 budget resolution. **He moved and Councilor Bright seconded the motion for approval.** During discussion, Short read aloud Taylor’s supportive comments then added his own. Mayor echoed Councilor Short, expressing his hope that the City will achieve a balanced budget through recurring revenues, instead of one-time ones. Councilor Bright thanked retired Carr Riggs accountant Brian Barksdale for his assistance with budget drafting. **UNANIMOUS Resolution No. 2024-52**

Councilor Short then introduced the proposed 3% COLA resolution. **He moved and Councilor Bright seconded the motion for approval. UNANIMOUS Resolution No. 2024-53**

With no further business to conduct, President Anderson adjourned the meeting at 8:09 am.
