Ordinance No. 2025 - CALG-ADM

An Ordinance Approving the Sale of Certain Property to the Utilities Board for the City of Trussville

WHEREAS, the City of Trussville, Alabama ("City") is presently the owner of certain real property consisting of approximately 1,381.60 acres on the eastern side of Deerfoot Parkway (the "Property");

WHEREAS, per Ordinance No. 2025-015-ADM, the City has already declared certain real property not presently needed for a public or municipal purpose to be declared surplus and to be disposed of through conveyance, in accordance with Section 11-47-20 of the Code of Alabama (1975); and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TRUSSVILLE, ALABAMA, pursuant to the authority granted by Section 11-47-20 of the Code of Alabama (1975), the mayor of the City of Trussville, Alabama is hereby authorized and directed to execute and close an agreement of purchase and sale in the name of the City of Trussville, Alabama with the Utilities Board of the City of Trussville in the amount of \$8,391,032.48 to effectuate the sale of the Property. A copy of the Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption, approval, and publication as required by law.
