SEPTEMBER 2, 2025 SPECIAL SESSION – CANVASSING BOARD

The City Council met in **special session** as the canvassing board on **Tuesday, September 2, 2025**, at 9 am to review the returns from the August 26 municipal elections.

The city clerk reported that ten provisional ballots were submitted to the Jefferson County Board of Registrars. Of those, eight were confirmed city voters; their ballots would be added to the final tally. While the canvassing board reviewed the election tapes, the city clerk opened eight sets of envelopes. Each candidate for public office received at least one additional vote. The city clerk then announced the final numerical total received by each candidate.
