

Ordinance No. 2026-004 -ADM


An Ordinance to Amend the Code of Ordinances Section 2-262, Expanding the Size of the Trussville Historical Board to Nine Member from Seven, with Staggered Terms Ending in 2028 & 2029, Respectively, Prior to a Four-Year Full Term Appointment

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Trussville, Alabama, that *Section 2-262* of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read, as follows:

Sec. 2-262. Members.

Two additional positions are hereby created on the Trussville Historical Board, bringing the total membership of this body to ~~nine~~ ~~seven~~. Board members shall be appointed by the City Council of the City of Trussville for a term of four years. The initial terms of these two members shall be staggered in the following manner: one member shall be appointed for a term through April 5, ~~2028~~ ~~2007~~; and one member shall be appointed for a term through April 5, ~~2029~~ ~~2008~~.


